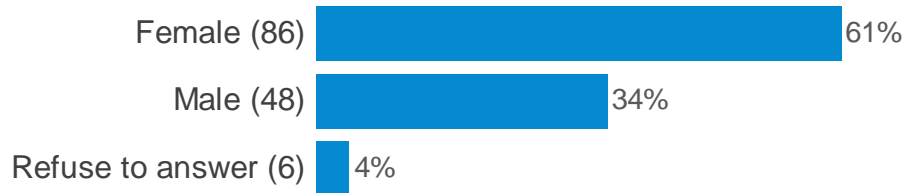

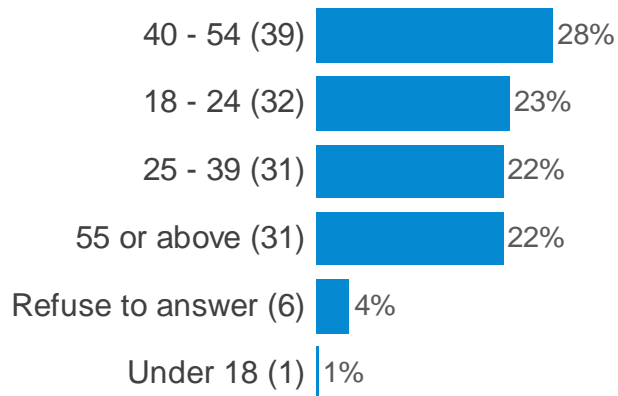
This report was generated on 04/17/19. Overall 142 respondents completed this questionnaire. The report has been filtered to show the responses for 'All Respondents'.

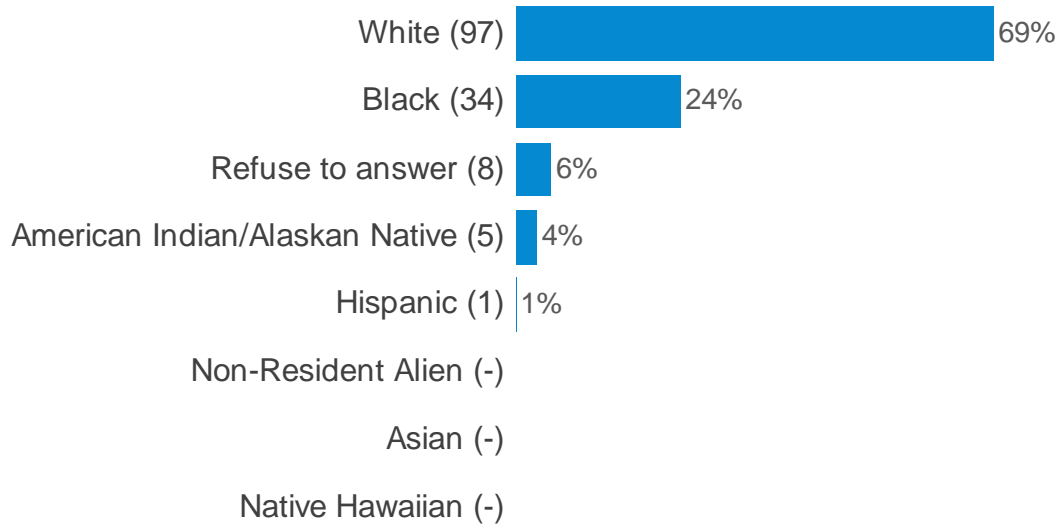

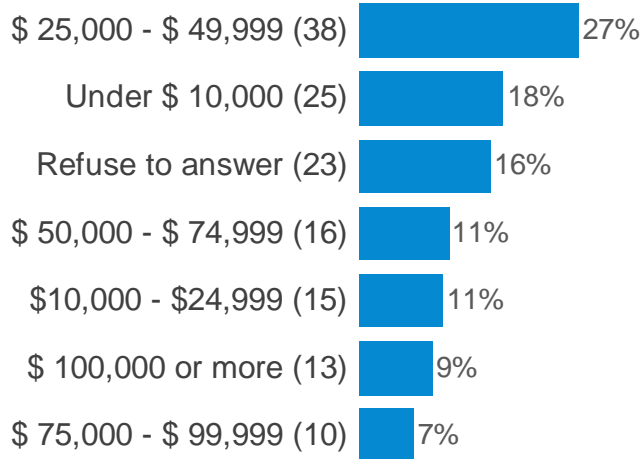

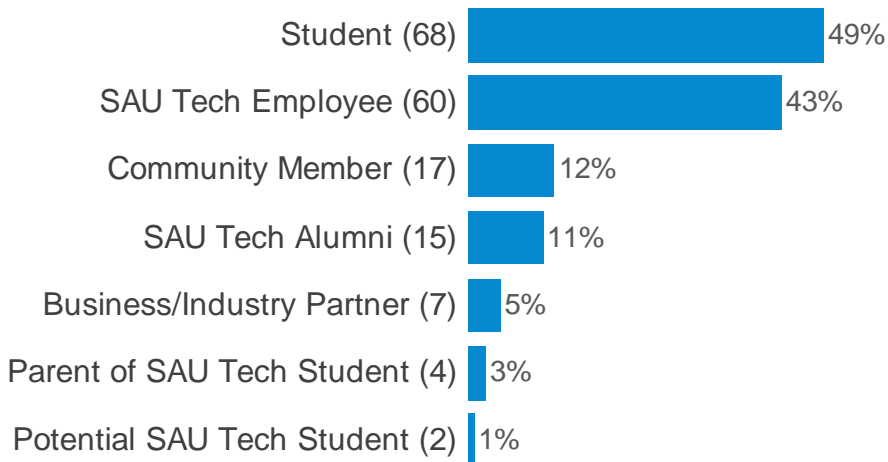

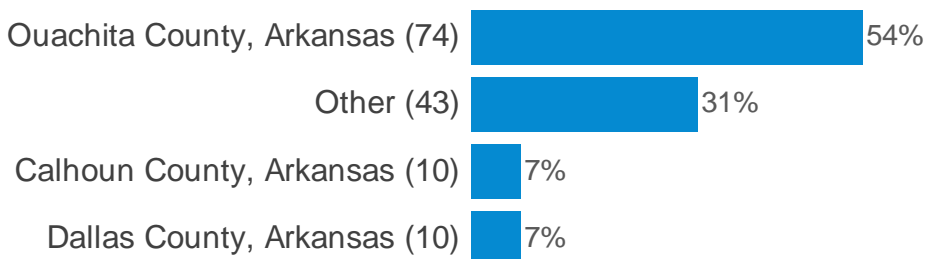

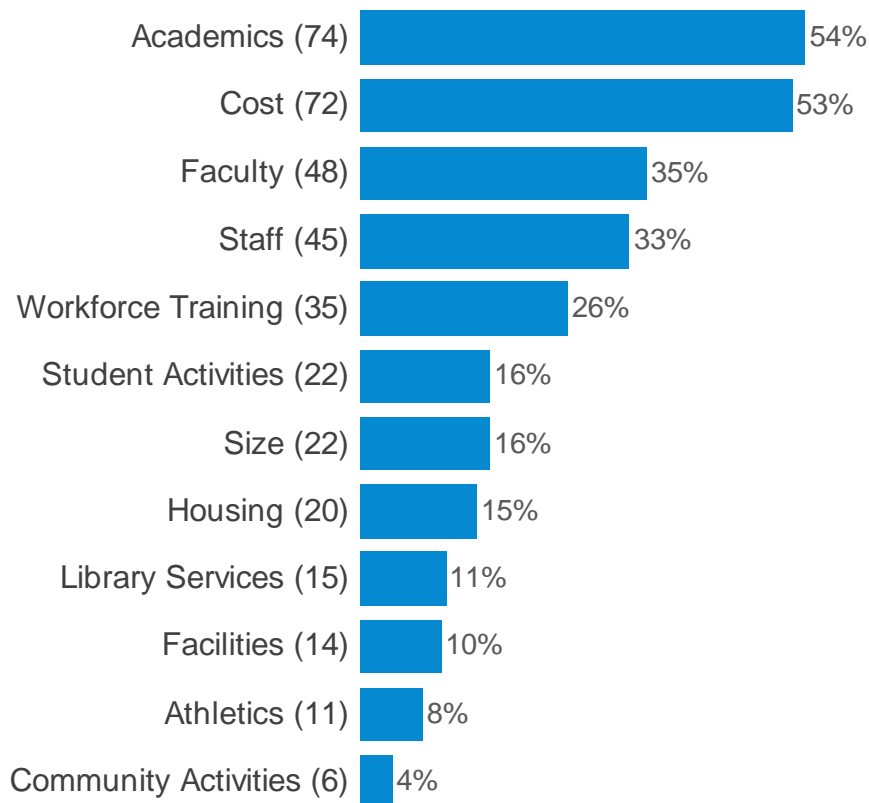

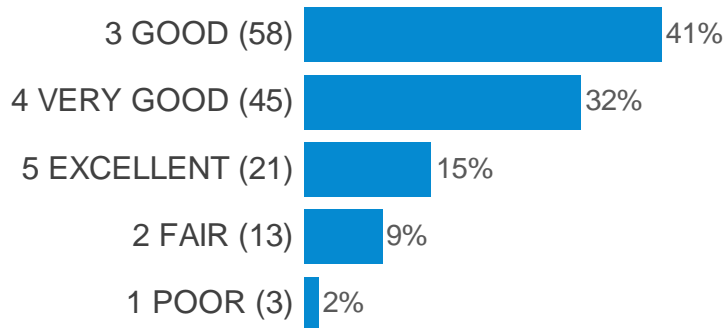
### Which areas of SAU Tech do you believe are the strongest at the college? Select three (3) only



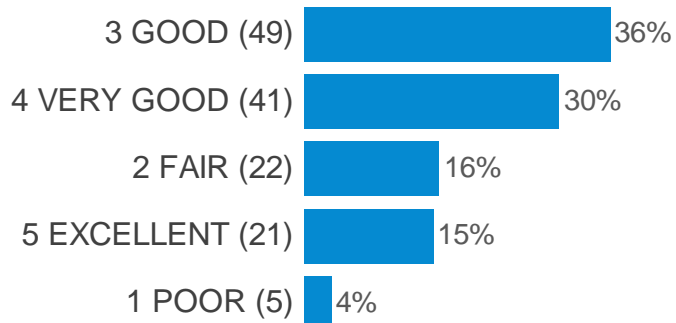
What do you perceive to be SAU Tech's three (3) main goals? Select three (3) only



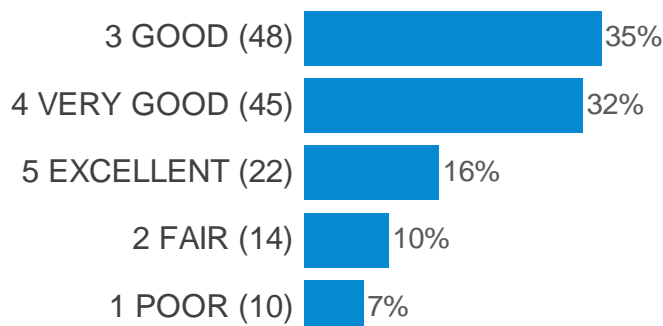
Using the scale below, please rate SAU Tech on how well it meets the needs of these categories. (Business/Industry)



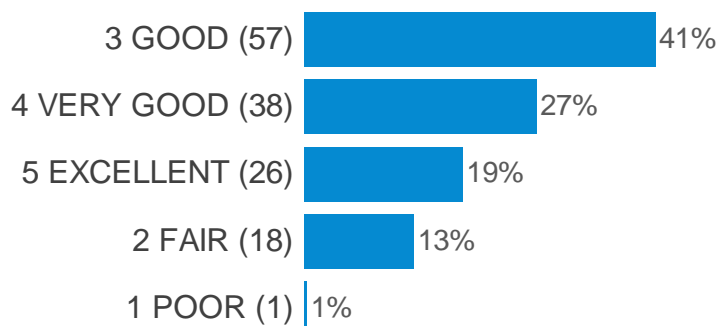
Using the scale below, please rate SAU Tech on how well it meets the needs of these categories. (Community)

Now that you have athletics, you can use them to "make it cool" to want to go to Tech. Don't scoff at that--I attended the University of Arkansas for one reason and one reason only: I was a Razorbacks fan from the time I was 8 years old. "Five years"? Then concentrate on getting your name, pictures of your campus & and student life there, and your sports teams & facilities embedded into the minds of the 7th graders & younger classes. DO NOT IGNORE THE ELEMENTARY STUDENTS! As a child, it was the white razorback against the cardinal background that mesmerized me; it was the success of the Razorbacks football team, AND THE FACT THAT EVERYONE WAS TALKING ABOUT THEM. It was pre-internet, but pervasive. You now have one of the best logos and color schemes I've ever seen. The community now needs to SEE and HEAR about you constantly. MAKE yourself the college and team of the area. Camden Fairview, Camden Harmony Grove, Bearden, Hampton--these four high schools especially--should come to think of themselves as your satellites. Flood them with perks from SAU Tech. Invite them to your campus and events constantly. If possible even work with their coaches about coordinating the basketball schedules so that there are some free dates to invite their basketball teams to attend your games. Maybe play a couple exhibition games at the high schools. In short, just stay in constant contact with the schools and get that Rocket logo out there.

Despite being the only community college in this area, we do not seem to have a strong presence in town or even on our own campus. There are plenty of events that transpire that seem to happen out of the blue.

Student graduation rates and retention, employee morale, more campus housing, more full time faculty, make improvements to buildings and facilities on campus, increase staff in understaffed areas, and upgrade campus technology where able and necessary.

Take the focus off of academics to transfer. Allow the student to complete their education and begin giving back to society in the workforce. Meet the students where they are in terms of gpa and test scores. Do not overload students the first semester, setting them up for failure. Advise the students about the amount of work involved in classes they may be interested in. Suggest Adult Ed for those students who will be in remediation the first two semesters. Offer testing to see where the student's strengths and weaknesses are so that the program they choose will fit their need and not just numbers for the school. Employ the "right people" in the right jobs.....get rid of the dead weight employees who coast along expecting others to do their jobs, refusing to carry their own load to reach the common goal of success for everyone involved.

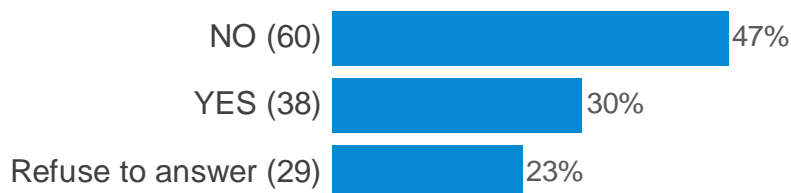
Focus on accepting students who are willing to work diligently in their studies. Mentoring should also be a top priority in selecting and retaining quality students.
