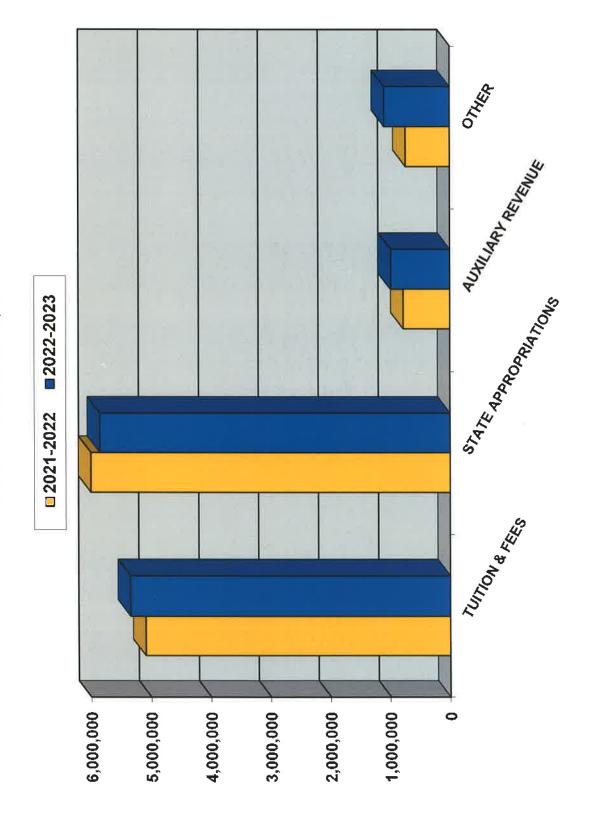
REVENUE

- State Appropriations is based on Categories A and B of the Revenue Stabilization Act and the Educational Excellence Trust Funds for a total of \$ 5,851,828.
- The resident tuition rate will increase by 1.9% to \$110 per credit hour. The non-resident rate will remain at \$156. \$110/\$156
- Tuition revenue is based on 31,611 SSCH generation.
- A new science fee will be added for Biology and Health Science courses. \$150 per course.
- The Diagnostic Sonography program will include three new fees: Program Fee \$750 per course, Testing Fee \$1,050 payable over four semesters, and a \$90 Subscription Fee payable in the first and fourth semesters.
- The following academic programs charge specific fees associated with curriculum, testing, licensure, and/or lab kits: Nursing, Cosmetology, Welding, Aviation, Medical Office, Non-Destructive Testing, HVACR Diagnostic Sonography, Biology Science, Health Science & Computer Information Technology.
- The forecast for Workforce Training revenue is \$427,200.
- Minor adjustments to Sales/Services budgets based on 2021-2022 actuals and projections.
- Student Housing income is based on average 90% occupancy.
- Great Western Dining Services will become the new food service provider for the college effective July 2022.
- Administrative Allowance for the AFTA and AETA remains at 10% of general revenue.

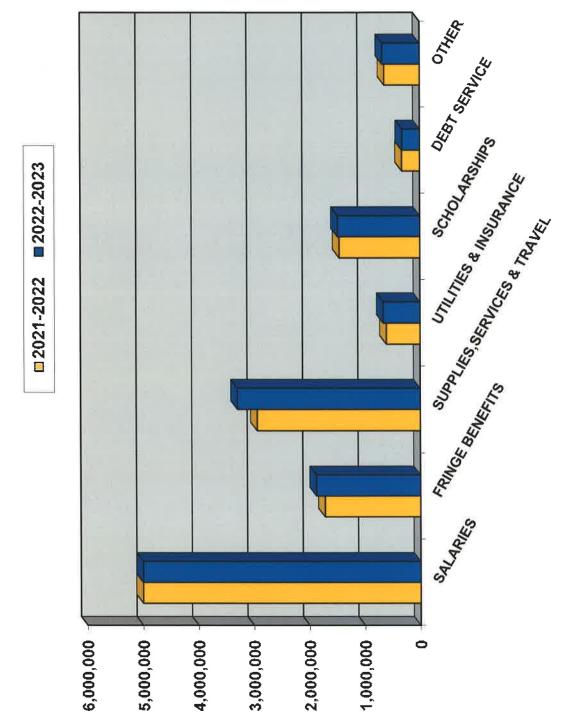
EXPENDITURES

- The budgeted salaries include a 1% COLA; however minor adjustments have been made to select positions that have taken on additional responsibilities due to restructuring.
- The group health coverage reflects a 9.9% increase in premium. The college will be moving from Health Advantage coverage to Arkansas Blue Cross.
- The Workforce Training budget is based on fifty-five (55) training courses.
- Minor adjustments have been made to the operational accounts for supplies, services, travel and equipment.
- E & G budget includes a \$215,098 athletic transfer to auxiliary.

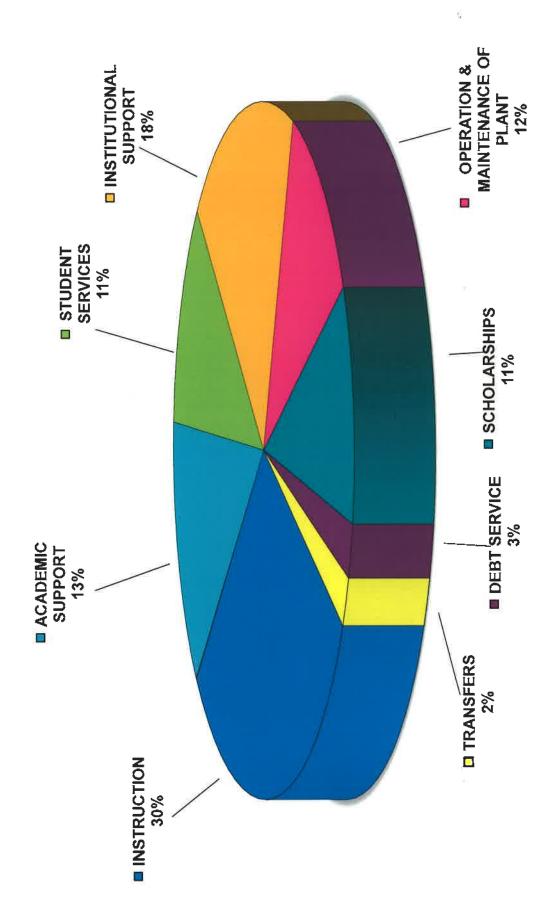

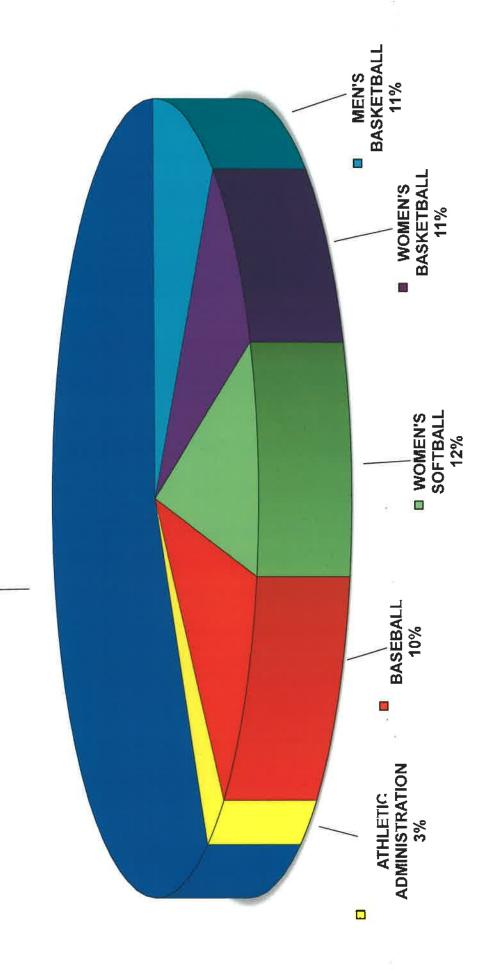

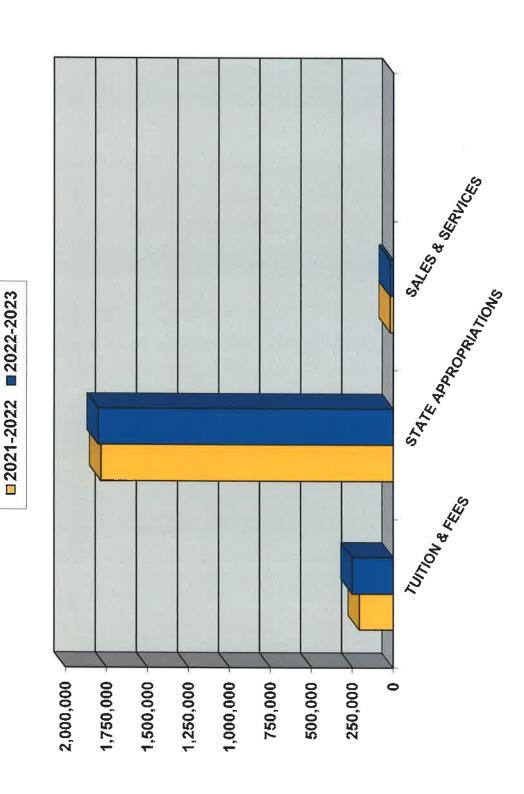
REVENUE

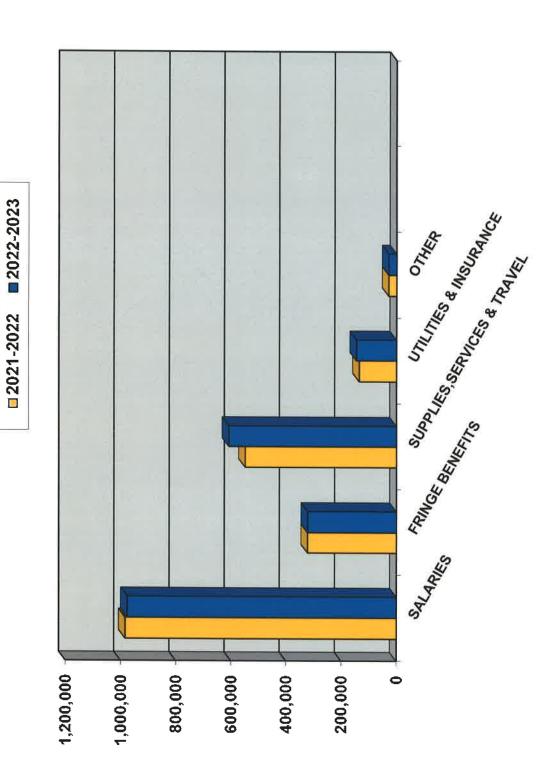
EXPENDITURES

- The budgeted salaries include a 1% COLA along with an adjustment for the increase in fringe benefit matching.
- The group health coverage reflects a 9.9% increase in premium. The AFTA will be moving from Health Advantage coverage to Arkansas Blue Cross.
- The on campus programs include the mandated training for the Firefighter Standards, Arson Investigations as well as other programs that enhance firefighter skills to better serve the community. These include EMS Training, Driver/Operator, Instructor, International Accreditation, and Officer.
- The off campus training allows for fire departments to conduct training locally by AFTA or fire department personnel.
- The AFTA staff administers the NFIRS reporting which includes monthly quality control reporting by the fire departments.
- Meals and Lodging are provided for all students attending on campus programs.
- AFTA trains over 1,000 fire departments (paid and volunteer), over 15,000 firefighters and issues over 22,000 certificates in a training year.

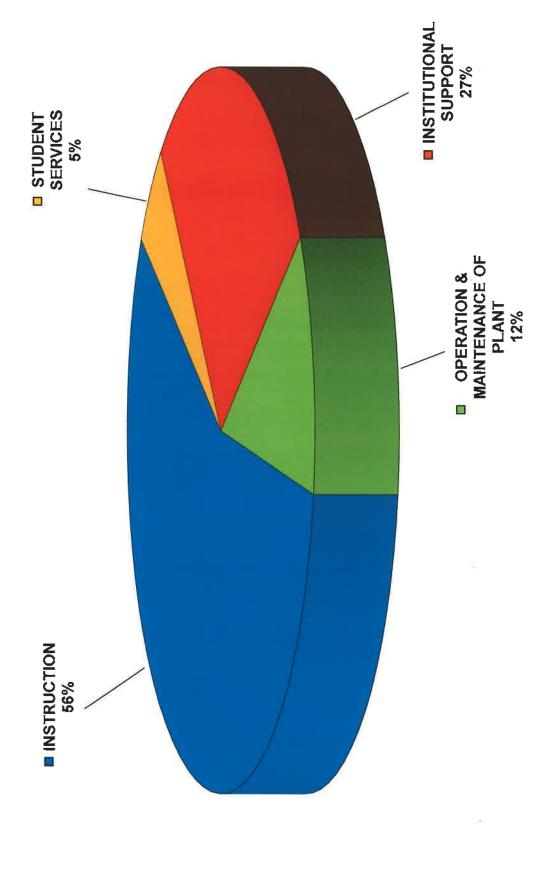

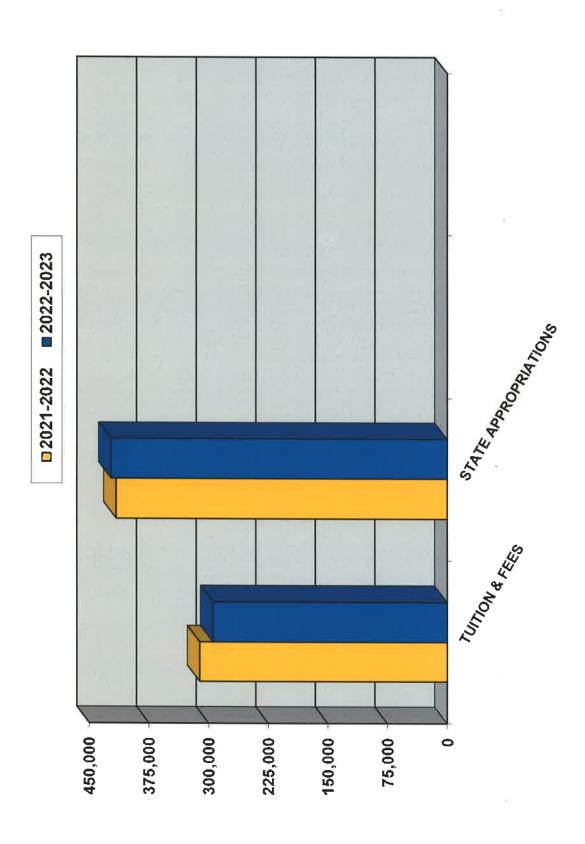

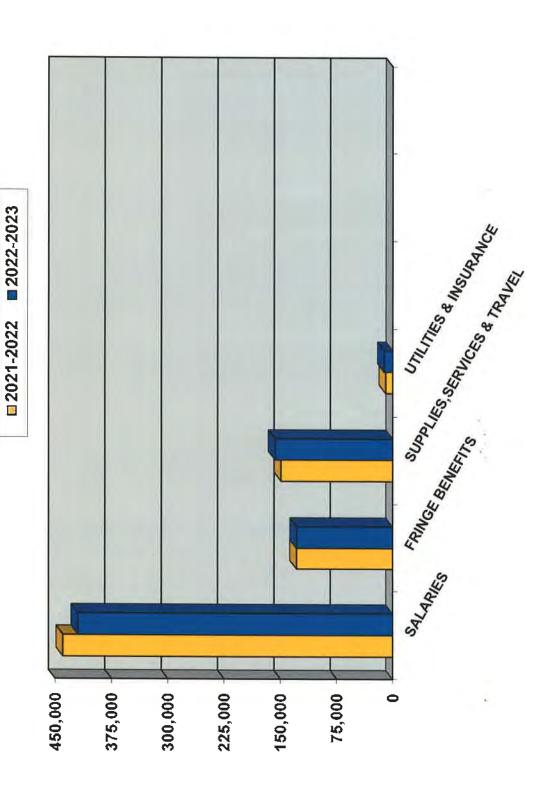

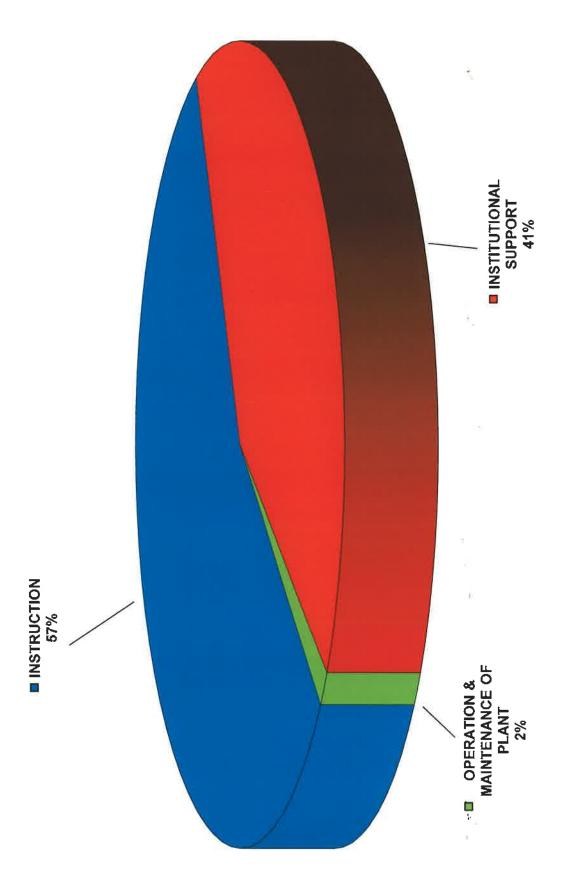

FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2023



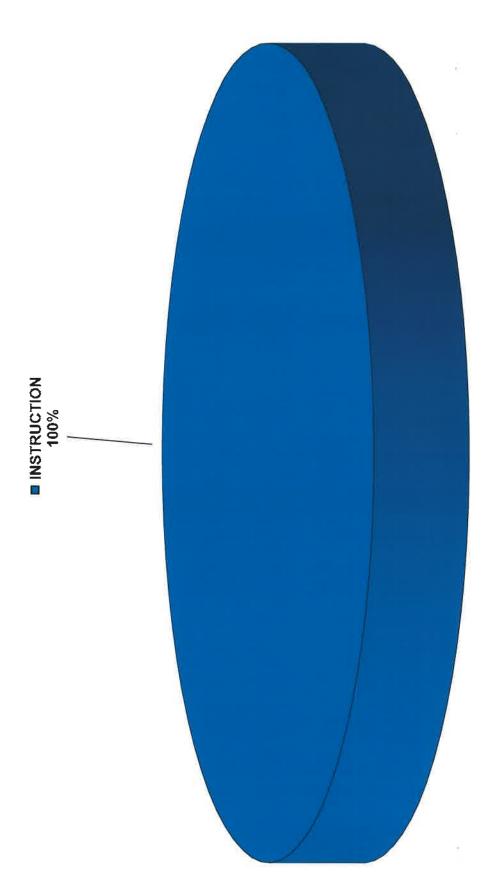
