## Email and Email Interviews

Last Name, First Name of Sender. "Re: Subject Line." Received by First Name Last Name of Person Who Received the Email, Day [Abbreviated Month](#). Year in which email was sent.

@twitterhandle. "Complete Content of Tweet." *Twitter*, Day [Abbreviated Month](#). Year of Posting, [time](#), twitter.com/urloftweet.

Last Name of User, First Name of User or Username. "First Few Words of the Facebook Post ...". *Facebook*, Day [Abbreviated Month](#). Year of Post, URL without http://.

## Video (Youtube, Vimeo, etc)

[Last Name, First Name of Creator](#). "Title of Video." *Video Site's Name*, uploaded by First Name Last Name or Alias of Uploader, Day [Abbreviated Month](#). Year of Upload, URL without http://.

## Comment on a Website or Article

Username of Commentor. Comment on "Title of Article." Publisher, Day [Abbreviated Month](#). Year of Posting, time that the comment was posted, url without http://.

## Essay in a Collection

Last Name of Author, Initial. (Year of publication). Title of essay. In *Title of collection* (pp. [first page number-last page number](#)). City name, Initials of State: Publisher.

## How to Format an MLA Paper

Most students think a paper's content is the most important part. This sentiment is generally correct. However, a poorly formatted essay will not only make for a disorganized appearance and a poor impression - it could also harm the student's grades and make the student's arguments less credible as the reader might have trouble checking the student's references. Ideally, every section of the paper should be correctly formatted according to MLA formatting guidelines. Formatting an MLA paper requires that the writer focuses on the first page, the headings, in-text citations, and the Works Cited Page.

The first page of an MLA paper has four components that require specific formatting. The first of these is the page number. The page number should be right-aligned in the page's header and should be preceded by the writer's last name. Make sure that that first page number is '1'. The second section includes the writer's name, the professor's name, the subject name, and the date of submission. These elements should be double-spaced in 12-point Times New Roman font and aligned on the left-hand side of the first page. In addition, the date must be written as "day month, and year" — for example: "20 February 2016".
