

## Dream Team Meeting Tuesday, August 25, 2020 Time: 11:00am Location: Zoom

Courtney Haygood reported that there are currently 100 new housing students. Twenty-five of the 100 have completed the Intake Survey.

The following objectives were identified to measure the success of this project:

- 1. 50% of the students in the control group will take advantage of identified services.
- 2. The success rate of the control group students who use identified services will be \_\_\_% higher than the control group students who do not.
